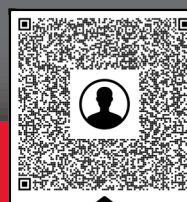

## THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- Peer-Led Team Learning (PLTL) is built into biology and chemistry classes. These once-a-week sessions are mandatory just like going to class.

## If you haven't done these things already, do them by Monday (8/26):
