

The Emeritus College Faculty Awards

PURPOSE AND ELIGIBILITY

The SIUE Emeritus College Faculty Award Competition provides project/program support for current SIUE tenured and tenure-track faculty that is not elsewhere supported by the University, such as research, development of teaching skills, and individual professional development. Projects/programs which strengthen the academic quality of the University and enhance its reputation are encouraged.

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES, include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Departmental speaker series that involves recognized outside experts brought to campus for colloquia for students, faculty, and staff
- Curricular development (disciplinary or interdisciplinary)
- Faculty exchanges, including international faculty exchanges
- Scholar-in-residence programs

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- **Deadline:** Applications must be received by 5 p.m., Friday, March 15, 2024.
- **Submission:** Application should be emailed to: EmeritiFacultyAssociation@siue.edu
- **Applications** must include the following elements:
 - **Please use the attached Cover Sheet**
 - **Project Narrative** (three to five pages, double-spaced in 12-point font) including:
 - Project Abstract (150 words or less)
 - Introduction/purpose
 - Project/Program's Goal's and Activities
 - Project/Program's Potential Impact upon Academic Program(s)
 - Proposed Itemized Budget (including source(s) of additional funding)
 - Statement of Support from any External Sponsor/Donor
- **Awards:** Proposals may request a maximum of \$5,000. If the Applicant has no other sources of funds, awards will rarely exceed \$2000. Cost sharing is encouraged, but not required. Cost sharing involving sponsors/donors from outside of SIUE is particularly encouraged.
- **Project Presentation:** Recipients are expected to make a short presentation at the Emeritus College Annual Spring Meeting, the following year.
