

Kuali Proposal Types

TYPE	DEFINITION
Awarded Contract	A formal proposal process is not used (typically an industry contract) for a project/contract.
Budget /SOW Update	A proposal that has been awarded, but the award is contingent upon providing an updated budget/SOW. Proposal is to be linked to the original proposal's IP number.
Continuation	A proposal used when the sponsor requests a subsequent project period budget for an awarded multi-year project. (Funding is provided on a year-to-year basis).
Funds to Faculty/Dept.	New proposals in which the sponsor requires that the funds be given directly to the faculty member/student or program rather than SIUE and that will not be overseen or managed by ORP.
Internal	Not currently used.
Internship Agreement	Any standard internship agreement with an external sponsor (e.g. industry, non-profit, etc.).
New	A proposal being submitted to a sponsor for the first time.
New – Changed/Corrected	Used by ORP when a correction is needed on a new proposal being submitted to a sponsor for the first time. Use this when errors occur in S2S.
New In-Kind	A proposal in which the sponsor provides services or time rather than direct funding (e.g., time to use a computer server).
Personnel Change	When a PI change is needed for a proposal that has already been awarded.
Pre Proposal/ Letter of Intent	A pre-proposal or letter of intent that is required by the sponsor to determine who to invite to submit a full proposal and involves a tentative budget.
Renewal	A proposal being submitted to renew funding (non-competitive)
Renewal – Changed/Corrected	Used by ORP when a correction is needed for a renewal proposal. Use this when errors occur in S2S.
Resubmission	A proposal being submitted to a sponsor after initial rejection.
Resubmission – Changed/Corrected	Used by ORP when a correction is needed for a resubmission proposal. Use this when errors occur in S2S.
Revision/Supplement	A proposal that requests additional funding for an existing, awarded project during the awarded proposal's current project period.
Revision/Supplement – Changed/Corrected	Used by ORP when a correction is needed to a revision/supplement proposal. Use this when errors occur in S2S.
These designations have specific federal definitions and are related to S2S submissions.
