Instruction (11)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Only for creating educational change <input type="checkbox"/> Includes course and curriculum development, required preparatory/remedial instruction, and recruitment to degree programs
Research (12)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Activities related to produce one or more research outcomes (e.g. creation, reorganization and application of knowledge)
Research – Applied	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Original investigation directed towards a specific, practical aim or objective
Research – Basic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Experimental or theoretical work to acquire new knowledge without any particular application or use in view
Research – Experimental Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Systematic work drawing on knowledge gained from research & practical experience <input type="checkbox"/> Produces additional knowledge directed toward producing new products/processes or improving current products/processes
Research -Infrastructure Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Support for organized research infrastructure (e.g. ORP & ITS enhancements)
Public Service (13)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Responds to community need or solves community problems, including internships and projects where majority of outreach is for external audiences
Academic Support (14)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Direct support of Instruction, Research & Public Service <input type="checkbox"/> Activities related to preservation, maintenance & display of the stock of knowledge and education materials <input type="checkbox"/> Activities related to administration of academic programs, including library and museum services
Student Services (15)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Activities related to contributing to emotional/physical/intellectual/cultural development of students outside formal instruction <input type="checkbox"/> Includes cultural events, counseling and career guidance, admissions and recruitment
Institutional Support (16)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Activities related to day-to-day functioning & long range viability <input type="checkbox"/> Includes support services to serve faculty & staff and to maintain relations with local community alumni governmental entities, and the public (e.g. news releases, newsletters, alumni events, etc.)
Scholarships & Fellowships (18)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Grants-in-aid, trainee stipends, tuition and fee waivers and prizes to undergraduate students <input type="checkbox"/> Grants-in-aid and trainee stipends to graduate students.
