LRC 2020 in Review and What's to Come in 2021

Like everyone everywhere, we here at the LRC have had to change the way we operate. Though we've been closed to the general public much of the year, we are still serving patrons. Crafty Fridays and children's story hours have continued throughout the pandemic's mandated closures. Programming shifted to virtual formats through Zoom and Facebook. Our social media presence has grown and if you haven't already, please check out our Facebook page www.facebook.com/siue.esl.lrc.1 and like us.

We offer services for library check out of books, dvds and other materials. Print requests can still be made and picked up in our contactless wall pockets outside the library doors. Virtual programming and assistance to patrons will still be offered and in more abundance. Last year, patrons of the library saved a collective \$8540.81 in costs due to checking out those materials from our library and through interlibrary loan services, instead of purchasing.

Here are some other notable changes within the SIUE EStL Campus LRC/Library:

Now offering door-side pickup/drop-off & curbside if requested.

- •Call, email, or stop by the LRC and knock if you need services.

LRC/Library Renovations:

The LRC/Library underwent renovations during the closure and added a new group room space. The computer lab received updated and new desks to allow other devices to be used with USB ports. The new group room will allow larger in house group programming in the future, and we hope to have a Smart Board added by the end of 2021. This would give us the ability to hold in house group and virtual programming, sometimes simultaneously. We look forward to the continued updates and the ability to have in house group programming again, hopefully by fall of 2021.

Writing Group


SIUE graduate student and MFA candidate Bart Dziegielewski (Bart DZ) will host a virtual six-week writing group on Thursdays, February 25th
