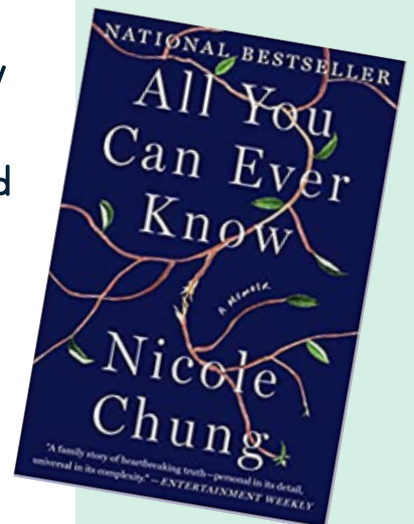
April is Earth Month

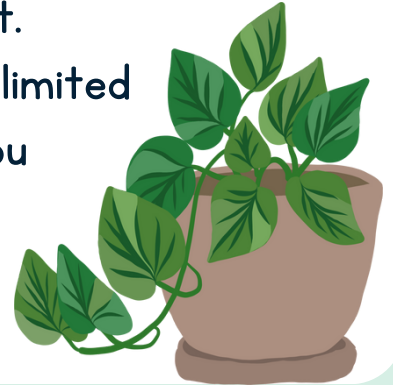
