
Bullying Professional Development:

CDA PROGRAM

BEGIN YOUR CAREER AS A CERTIFIED CHILD DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATE

There is no fee for this program, which will be led by an instructor from Lewis & Clark College. Upon successful completion of the certification, you will be immediately eligible for an on-thejob apprenticeship at one of the SIUE Head Start Centers.

You will also need to attend a professional development program for two weeks before the CDA class begins. The course is offered by Connections to Success and there will be no cost to you.

The professional development class runs from 9:00 am - 3:00 pm, June 17th—28th at the East St. Louis Center (Room TBD).

- Social Security card for all household members
- birth certificate
 - current medical card (Medicare or Medicaid), if applicable
- High School Diploma, GED, or transcripts
- Proof of 90-day income from all sources for all household members
- Any family member in the household 18 or over with no income must provide:
- O proof applied for financial assistance
- (e.g., child support, SSA, SSI, TANF, GA, etc.)
 O OR if unemployed, provide an IL Job Link from the IL Dept. of Employment Security (with current activity for job searches) or current school schedule
- O If receiving unemployment, proof of Payment Detail Sheet from the IL Dept. of Security office from start to current
- O Proof of residency: Current lease or occupancy permit
