- Housing payment is included with first bill from the Bursar's office.

WHAT TO BRING


- Extra-long twin or extra-long full sheets

- Computer (wireless internet and data jacks are available)
- Ethernet cord
- Cleaning products (residents are responsible for cleaning their room and bathroom)

WHAT <u>NOT</u> TO BRING

- Pets (aquarium fish are permitted)
- Alcohol containers, empty or full
- Cooking appliances with open elements
- LED lights on adhesive strip
- Liquid bleach
- Wireless printers (our network requires a cable connection)



MAINTENANCE REQUESTS

- University Housing Facilities
 Management (UHFM) responds to all maintenance requests
- 94% of work order requests are completed within three business days
- 91% are completed with 48 hours of being submitted

- Must be connected to campus WiFi to submit a request





BREAK PERIODS

- First-year halls (Bluff, Prairie and Woodland) close during breaks.
 - Fall Break (November 22 at 5 p.m.-December 1 at 10 a.m.)
 - Winter Break (December 15 at 5 p.m.-January 12 at 10 a.m.)
 - Spring Break (March 7 at 5 p.m.-March 16 at 10 a.m.)
- Evergreen Hall and Cougar Village remain open during break periods.














MEAL PLANS
