Students have 2 options when pursuing a Bachelor's degree in Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology (SPPA).

- A Bachelor of Arts degree will require 2 semesters of the same foreign language, which can be taken at either KC or SIUE, in addition to 8 Humanities and/or Fine Arts Courses (some of which will be completed with the Associate in Arts.)
- A Bachelor of Science degree will require completion of 8 courses in life, physical, or social science, in addition to 2 courses with a lab component.

DECLARATION REQUIREMENTS

- A cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher (on a 4.0 scale)

SPPA RETENTION AND GRADUATION POLICY

- A cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher (on a 4.0 scale)
- A grade of "B" or higher in SPPA 201, Human Communication and its Disorders (offered only at SIUE)
- Grades of "C" or higher in all other coursework required for the major, including 12 hours in related areas: behavioral science (PSYH 101, biological science (Life Science), physical science (CHEM or PHYS – PHYS preferred), and statistics (MATH 136).
