Kishwaukee College Transfer Planning Guide – Traditional Transfer Option

Admission Requirements

- Admission to the University (requires submission of a University application and \$40 fee)
- Transfer students who have attempted at least 30 semester hours in courses will be automatically admitted to SIUE and eligible for Direct Entry to the Nursing major provided they have earned a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA (4.0 scale) in coursework at the previous accredited school(s) attended.
- Transfer students who have attempted fewer than 30 semester hours in courses must meet transfer admission criteria AND first-time freshmen criteria to be automatically admitted to SIUE and eligible for Direct Entry to the Nursing major.

The following is a list of courses Kishwaukee students should take while preparing to transfer to SIUE. These courses *should* be completed prior to matriculating to SIUE and *must* be completed with a grade of 'C' or higher to be eligible to enroll in SIUE Nursing courses. Students not completing these courses prior to transferring will be required to complete them at SIUE prior to enrolling in Nursing courses.

¹ Students cannot complete this requirement at Kishwaukee. SIUE recommends completing the requirement upon transfer or by taking an online equivalent from Parkland College (CHEM 107) or the equivalent at McHenry County College (CHM 170). Note: these options are out-of-district. For additional recommendations, contact Kishwaukee or SIUE academic advisor.

Additional Information:

- BIO 109 or BIO 201 is waived for Kishwaukee students who complete BIO 258 with a 'C' or better.
- If earning an AA/AS, students may still need an additional three years at SIUE to complete all the BSN requirements.
- All science courses must be completed within 7 years of admission to the program.
