*Application deadline for admission for Fall term is **February 1**.

Admission Requirements:

- 1. Completion of all skills/foundations courses (or approved equivalents) with a grade of C or better.
- 2. The grade of B or higher in EDUC 232 Intro to Special Ed.
- 3. Fewer than 5 non-partnership courses remaining.
- 4. Combined GPA (all post-secondary work) of 2.5 or higher.
- 5. Good academic standing at SIUE (if applicable)
- 6. Completion of 42 semester hours or more of college level course work.
